# Crete Bus Tour with Knossos Friday, October 3rd



Today we will take in a full day bus tour taking in the ruins at Knossos, the old town of Rethymno, the Fortezza (the castle) and a stop at Plakias village. Lunch is at "Plateia Taverna" at Myrtos village.

Crete is home of the great Minoan Civilization and the mythological

home of Zeus. After a short drive through the town of Heraklion the tour will arrive at the Knossos excavations. Here, Sir Arthur Evan's archaeological discoveries revealed a civilization dating back to 4000 B.C., when a great empire flourished on the island of Crete. Based on the wealth of artefacts that were found, Evans theorized that this was the site of the ancient Minoan Kingdom. These findings will be viewed in detail, as your guide will lead you on a journey of discovery to learn of the sophisticated culture that flourished thousands of years ago on this island. The Palace, decorated



with frescoes and shields houses the Hall of the Royal Guard, the Hall of the Double Axes, the King's Chamber with the alabaster throne, the Queen's Apartment, beautiful courtyards and shrines. **THIS TOUR IS INCLUDED** 

# **Bus Tour with Villages and Wine Tasting Saturday, October 4th**



It's another full day of exploring this incredible island. We will start off with a tour of the Apokoronas villages. We'll Discover charming and authentic villages like Vrysses, a lovely village with running springs and lush greenery, Emprosneros, surrounded by an entire forest of oaks and inhabited by only 300 permanent residents, and Fres, a quiet and sleepy village without much tourism with a large village square with tavernas and shops. The drive is along beautiful scenic routes.

Our tour will also include stops at <u>Aptera</u> where we will visit impressive Roman cisterns, ruins of Roman bath houses, a newly excavated theater and the monastery of Agios Ioannis Theologos. We'll also visit the <u>Gavalohori Museum</u> with its impressive collection of Silk, Pottery, Kopaneli (*lace*), Stone carving, Wood carving, coins, costumes, guns and swords.

We will visit a local winery called <u>Dourakis</u> for a guiding around their estate. We will taste the indigenous and international grape varieties as they are expressed on Cretan terroir, meet a passionate family of winemakers and learn about the uprising of viniculture on the island. We will then continue our exploration of the region, where villages preserve a special traditional color and life continues in the old traditional way. The area offers spots of great natural beauty and interesting drives off of the main highway. Late afternoon return at your hotel.

## Santorini by land and Sea

Visit: Akrotiri - Volcano - Hot Springs - Thirassia

Monday, October 6th



This tour will include a land tour by bus, then a sailing tour on a beautiful, traditional Greek wooden boat.

Program: First we visit the important archaeological site of Akrotiri which was closed for many years but reopened in 2012. Akrotiri Excavations brought to light a Minoan town preserved under the pumice for 3000 years. Our expert guide will lead an interesting and informative tour in the ancient town. From there we will visit a very cute town called Pyrgos

where we will have time to walk to the top along winding, narrow walkways. Excellent photos! We will also go to the mountaintop of Profitis Ilias where we will enjoy an incredible view.

Then we go by bus to Athinios Port. There you will board the beautiful traditional boat that will sail on to reach the lava islet Nea Kameni where we leave the boat and walk an ascending soil path to approach the crater of the still active **Volcano**. Then back to the boat and we sail to the second lava islet called Palea Kameni. There we find **Hot Springs** and we can have a swim in



the green Sulphur waters or even take a bath in the warm therapeutic mud. After a half hour the boat will sail to the nice traditional island <u>Thirassia</u>. There we can have free time for lunch, explore the island or swim at the beach next to the port. This is one of the best days of the entire trip. You've got to do this! **THIS TOUR IS INCLUDED** 

You may also bring your own drinks on board the boat. We can stock up in the harbor before boarding.



## Free Day in Santorini Tuesday, October 7th

Another idea is to just enjoy a nice walk with your camera. I like the walk I did to the nearby town of <u>Firostefani</u>. Less touristy, quiet and very picturesque.

## Catamaran Sailing – private cruise



## Wednesday, October 8th

Depart from Vlychada port and Sail to the Red and White beach to admire the unique formations. You will stop for a swim stop at Mesa Pigadia Beach, and marvel at the black menir and the small caves. Head to the Caldera through the Indian Rocks and pass by the Venetian Lighthouse. Stop at the hot springs for a swim in the sulfurous waters and snorkel by the Volcano while the crew prepares the hot meal of Chicken fillet, pasta with tomato sauce, greek salad, tzatziki dips, vine leave rolls, bread. Soft beverages & white wine are also included. This is a 5-hour tour that includes transfers and 3-stops for snorkeling.
